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INTERVIEW WITH JOSÉ ABASCAL

Director of Salesians Sarrià

Salesians Sarrià provides a post-compulsory educational training offer that allows students to choose the course of education best suited to their professional future and job market requirements.

Salesians Sarrià recently became a member of the UNESCO Associated Colleges Project Network (ASPNet). What added value does this distinction provide to the college?

The UNESCO enshrines the objectives of science, culture and education, taking peace, sustainability, internationalisation and health into account at all times. This year we joined the UNESCO Associated Colleges Project Network (ASPNet), which has acknowledged the work we do, since our college is committed to providing an education based on the values it advocates.

This acknowledgement goes well beyond the academic setting, promoting a more global and valuesbased education.

As of this year we are part of a network of 10,000 educational institutions in 181 countries whose objective is to work jointly for peace and intercultural dialogue, among other things.

A year has passed since the green roof was installed, what appraisal would you make of this space?

A very positive one. The new green roof has a threefold objective: what matters most to the college is providing Higher-level VET Renewable Energies students with a practical training area, and now they have an area with photovoltaic panels where they can put what they learn in the classroom into practice. Secondly, the green roof is the college's first-ever green area, so now the yard has a green space of almost 200 m² which is also a renewable energy workshop.

The third objective is to provide Sarrià-Sant Gervasi district with a new green area, and ours is the first green roof in the district to win the "Green Roofs" competition organised by the City Council of Barcelona.

IN THIS NEW ACADEMIC YEAR WE WILL BE STARTING THE HIGHER-LEVEL VET AUTOMOTIVE COURSES

One of the actions undertaken to promote sustainability in the college was precisely the creation of the roof. What actions have you scheduled for the future?

After installing the roof, we planted 5 trees on the college's top yard, an action that will enjoy continuity this year with a further 5 trees to be planted in the downstairs yard. Another initiative we are working on is the possibility of building a vertical garden or a metal wall where plants and other vegetable species can be hung. To this end, we are working in collaboration with the Institut de Paisatge Urbà i Qualitat de Vida (IMPUQV) and with the Institut de Ciència i Tecnologia Ambientals (ICTA) to find the best solution for this space at the college.

Another action related to sustainability that we will be implementing is the installation of bicycle and electrical scooter charging stations at the college. In this way, pupils, teachers and administrative and services employees will be able to recharge their vehicles on the college premises. Yet another step in promoting sustainability and nonpollutant mobility through the college.

What activities is Salesians Sarrià engaging in to promote the internationalisation of its pupils?

The college facilitates the internationalisation of its Spanish Baccalaureate students through exchanges. In this 2019-2020 academic year we will have about 80 placements all around Europe, 25 of them in Denmark.

Moreover, we promote internationalisation among our Vocational Education and Training (VET) students by means of stays abroad, and this year we have more than 75 placements scheduled. We also work on joint projects with other colleges, such as a project for the manufacture of a machine by our mechanics department in collaboration with six European colleges.

WE WORK TOWARDS THE INTERNATIONALISATION OF OUR SPANISH BACCALAUREATE AND VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING STUDENTS

How do you address internationalisation in the institutional setting and from the different teaching departments?

Both the management and faculty are committed to forging relationships with European colleges in order to be present in the different education activities related to Vocational Education and Training and Spanish Baccalaureate conducted abroad, such as: fora, visits to colleges and by inviting their representatives to our college. In the first term, we visited Austria through the Talents for Europe programme, four of our teachers visited a vocational education and training campus in Holland and we also attended the Congress of the European Vocational Training Association that was held in the Azores.

Besides the programmes abroad, what actions are you implementing in order to improve language-learning?

Salesians Sarrià is committed to ensuring that its students are proficient in English when they complete their education. This is why we offer extra classes so they can improve their English, French and German. These classes are held at midday and are open to anyone at the college who wishes to improve their proficiency in a foreign language.

The aim is to promote learning through actually speaking the language, rather than based on grammar and spelling, as these aspects are dealt with in the compulsory English classes in their courses.

The International Baccalaureate has become consolidated as one of the post-compulsory education options. What does the Diploma Programme offer pupils?

The International Baccalaureate enables students to attend universities in more than 100 countries all over the world without having to get their qualification recognised. The international dimension depends largely on each student and whether they want to pursue their education abroad or here. The main goal of these courses is to prepare students to have an international mentality so that they can travel the world independently in the future.

Salesians Sarrià is a college that promotes innovation in the classroom. What methodologies does it employ to do this?

The college promotes teamwork, which is why our courses are based on Project-Based Learning (PBL) in Vocational Education and Training and on Cooperative Learning in the Baccalaureate. These two methodologies work to the benefit of students, because they bolster the skills and competencies now being demanded by companies.

¿What are the main competencies that students pick up working with PBL and Cooperative Baccalaureate? Students learn to be independent learners and also acquire the capacity to work in teams, two basic competencies they will need when they embark upon their professional career. Through these skills, students will be better poised to rise to new challenges and also to deal with the problems they face in the course of their education successfully. In this way, they learn that the world is not about individuality and that people have to get used to working as a team and with people they do not know.

What is the college's social commitment?

The social vocation is one of the strategic lines of Salesians Sarrià. For this reason, the college is committed to being a supportive institution that is engaged in two volunteer projects: Share the Light and Let's Revise Together. Through these two programmes, our intention is to promote a volunteer work mentality and a supportive spirit among our students.

Salesians Sarrià promotes sustainability both inside and outside the classroom through specific actions. In 2019, we started the green roof project, a space with a surface area of almost 200 m² which became the college "lung", and is also a working area for VET students.

The college wants its students to feel part of the Salesian community, which is why we have developed the Pastoral Educational Programme that sets out to provide an all-round person-centred education through different activities. Moreover, we promote internationalisation through different programmes that help to further our students' international side and allow them to cope successfully in an increasingly more global setting.

Presentation of Salesians Sarrià

Salesians Sarrià has more than 135 years of experience in post-compulsory education training. In the course of our history, we have always adapted to the needs of society to ensure that our students receive the best possible human and technical education.

Innovation in education is one of the college cornerstones. Our educational offer is underpinned by a **Dual Vocational Education and Training (Dual VET) approach and by Project-based Learning (PBL)** in VET courses and **cooperative learning** in the Spanish Baccalaureate. These two methodologies are focused on ensuring that our students become both renowned professionals and independent and responsible persons.

Our **innovative model** encourages the relationship between the student and the company, since they are brought into contact with each other from the very beginning of the students' education. The Salesians **employment exchange** brings students into contact with companies to facilitate job placement.

Student **internationalisation** is one of the collegermain commitments. Our **International Relations** department works on programmes involving exchanges between students from our college and European students, conversation classes, work-experience programmes for VET students as well as stays in Europe.

WE HAVE OPENED A NEW ASSEMBLY ROOM

This year we opened a new assembly room. It is a room with capacity for 400 people, boasting the latest technology and equipment required to host different activities.

The college makes every effort to protect its own environment and also to encourage sustainable habits throughout the educational community.

A MORE SUSTAINABLE COLLEGE

Sustainability is one of the college underpinning values, which is why we are committed to **different initiatives that help to foster sustainable habits** among the educational community. To name but some, in 2019, we installed a green roof, the college first-ever green space. Moreover, we work in raising awareness of the importance of waste and sustainable waste management, prioritising energy-saving..





A HEALTHIER COLLEGE

Salesians Sarrià is part of the **FEM SALUT** programme of the Agència de Salut Pública de Barcelona which sets out to help the community to lead a healthier life. Moreover, our Educational Psychology Service (SAPP) holds Emotional Education workshops designed to help students cope with stress, as well as other aspects that young people are concerned about. The healthier college project also engages families through the organisation of conference cycles about adolescence.

A MORE SUPORTIVE COLLEGE

Support and solidarity are values that we work on every year with our students. We schedule different activities for the entire community so that they can all do their bit in the different projects that we have undertaken in the college or in which we are involved. "Repassem Junts", the international volunteer programme "Share the Light", "Reparem Junts", the sale of Fair Trade products, food collection, the sale of solidarity cakes and the annual Bosco Run.

"Repassem Junts"

This project is the result of a joint collaboration between Salesians Sarrià and the Social Services of Sarrià district. For three years now, "Let's Revise Together" has been offering children from the neighbourhood a space for being together, education and recreation. The college provides boys and girls with a space where they can do their homework with the help of some of the Baccalaureate Students who help out in the programme. They also treat them to an afternoon snack and play time at the college. **The project was awarded the "Fem Cultura amb els colors de la UNESCO" accolade.**

The Bosco Run

At the end of January, around Don Bosco day, we also organise the Bosco Run charity race. The event reached its fourth edition in 2019, with more than 150 runners, attesting to the consolidation of the activity, which has become a veritable example of fair play and solidarity. The objective of the run is to achieve funding for the "**Repassem Junts**" project. It is intended for people of all ages and is split into different categories. **The fifth edition was held on January 26, 2020.**



Suportive college Share the Light

Share the Light is the **volunteer work project** that the Salesians Sarrià has been carrying out in the city of Mazabuca (Zambia) for five years now.

Students from the Higher Level VET, accompanied by their teachers, travel to Zambia every summer to engage in maintenance, volunteer work and international cooperation at the Hijas de María Auxiliadora orphanage in the city of Mazabuca. *City of Joy* is a care home for girls in a situation of risk and social exclusion. The Salesian community centre provides them with a homely and safe environment that helps them to grow personally and to work in order to accomplish their professional and personal objectives.

The project is possible thanks to the **collaboration** of the college with the Salesian College Farnborough in England and the collaboration of the educational community and the economic contribution of different companies.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The purpose of the programme is to provide support to young girls lacking in resources or future options in order to **embark upon an educational career** and therefore improve their professional prospects. We have been working to help these girls to be able to start to study a professional career.





NUTRITION PROGRAM

Disease or lack of work are two of the main stumbling blocks preventing young girls in Zambia from progressing and evolving on a personal and a professional level. City of Joy seeks to identify **the neediest and most vulnerable families** and helps them through the donation of food, clothes, blankets, somewhere to live, etc.

PORRIDGE CLUB

In the city of Mazabuca, more than 700 young boys and girls can attend the college free. The "Porridge club", as this project is known, provides these minors with a **free education as well as a daily meal at the college**, in many cases the only square meal that they get all day due to family circumstances.



Commited to sustainability

Sustainability is one of the cornerstones of the Salesians Sarrià and is a facet which, year after year, we strive to implement in all areas of the college, as well as to consolidate community engagement in all the actions that we carry out.

Thanks to the involvement of the pupils, teachers and members of the administration and services staff we get results in different areas. We thus promote a sustainable college that is committed to zero waste through the effort of the entire educational community.

Salesians Sarrià has been acknowledged as a member of the ASPNet (UNESCO Associated Colleges Project Network) which promotes international cooperation and peace through education.





LAST PROJECTS:

GREEN ROOF

It began last year and is the first project that is not limited solely to the college. It is the first green roof of the "Green Roofs" project of the City Council of Barcelona and also has a pedagogical purpose. The students of the Higher-Level VET in Renewable Energies do some of their classes in this area.

TREE PLANTING:

In order to have a more sustainable recreational area in the college, besides the green roof area, **ten trees** have been being planted in the college yard, in an action framed within our sustainable college project and which helps to promote a greener environment.

BICYCLE AND ELECTRIC SCOOTER PARKING:

In the future we intend to install a parking facility for bicycles and electric scooters in the yard. In this space, students, teachers and administrative and services staff will be able to recharge their vehicles thanks to the power produced by the photovoltaic panels.



FUTURE ACTIONS:

ICTA AGREEMENT:

The college is working with the Institute of Environmental Science and Technology to develop a **new green space**. The aim is to adapt the wall of the downstairs yard that leads out to the street in order to build a vertical or metallic wall that is also connected to the outside and hang plants on it.

SUSTAINABLE WASTE MANAGEMENT

We are working to implement **drinking water fountains** to dissuade students, teachers and members of the administrative and services staff from using disposable plastic containers. Moreover, another ongoing study features the installation and operation of a 3D printer that can recycle plastic bottles in order to reuse waste.



DON BOSCO GREEN ALLIANCE

Salesians Sarrià is part of the Don Bosco Green Alliance movement, an international group of young people of the Salesian family institutions which contributes to environmental action, thought and policies all over the world. Its mission is to create a safe environment that looks after life on our planet, while also forging a new generation of citizens and leaders who are committed to the environment.



International **relations**

The internationalisation of the educational community is an essential part of the college's project and is nurtured through participation in international initiatives as well as through the promotion of foreign languages.

The Salesians Sarrià International Relations department works to ensure that students receive a **human**, **professional and intercultural training that will enable them to access the European employment and academic market** without any constraints. To this end, we collaborate in training our students in foreign languages by means of different programmes.

EXCHANGES: PERSONAL AND ACADEMIC ADVANCEMENT

We provide students with the possibility of going on exchange programmes with European college to bolster their **international spirit and give them the chance to get acquainted with new cultures**. The experience involves two periods: our students go abroad and also host foreign students at their own homes.

LANGUAGE COURSES IN THE COLLEGE

Our training proposal is geared towards promoting the development of our students and their professional projection. We therefore offer **conversation classes in English, French and German and preparatory classes for the First Certificate and Advanced Exams**. In order to guarantee the best results, our teachers are qualified and experienced native speakers, and the classes are organised in small groups to facilitate the group dynamic.

ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME

Vocational Education and Training students can do their work experience abroad through the **Erasmus**

Programme. This gives the students a possibility of picking up work experience in European companies. This programme was deployed by the European Commission and is intended to give students a broader approach and a greater capacity to establish social relationships.

TEACHER TRAINING

We give our own teachers the chance to participate in **international programmes** where the classes are taught in English. This also guarantees that students are learning quality English in the classroom. They can also take part in English classes at the college to hone their language skills.

MULTILINGUAL COLLEGE CERTIFICATE

We have the Multilingual College Certificate awarded by the Escola Cristiana de Catalunya Foundation in recognition of our effort in promoting the internationalisation of the educational community through participation in international projects and language-learning.

International stays year 2019-2020

In the course of last year, Salesians Sarrià participated in different projects, activities and meetings in an international setting to promote the learning of foreign languages and learning how to cope and grow professionally beyond our borders.

TALENTS FOR EUROPE

The college Director, **José Abascal**, and the Head of Higher VET Studies, **Josep Cartañà**, travelled to Austria as part of the **Talents for Europe** programme. The intention of the project is to establish relations between the Spanish and Austrian Vocational Training Systems. The Salesians Sarrià delegation visited different installations and companies that host students on work experience schemes, as well as Vocational Education and Training colleges.



EFVET CONFERENCE

The head of Dual VET, **Miguel A. Buendía**, attended the 28th Annual **EfVET International Conference** held in Portugal, titled "Robots. Human, Capital and Digital Learning" in order to share experiences and strategies related to the future of Vocational Education and Training with the other EfVET partners. This meeting yielded several possible international collaborations through the ERASMUS+ European Programme.



STAY IN CZECH REPUBLIC

The IT teacher **Santiago Fuentes** travelled to the Czech Republic to attend the meeting organised by the City Council of Prague with the support of the **Xarxa FP**. Attendees from eight European colleges got the chance to find out more about their educational system and the characteristics of Vocational Education and Training in the Czech Republic.



ERASMUS+ EUROPEAN PROJECTS

KA1 - PROJECT

The students from Higher-Level VET from different specialities got work experience in a foreign company over a three-month period in order to hone their professional and language skills. It is their first contact with the job market, and moreover in a European setting. The students say that the experience is a very enriching one that helps them to solve problems...

KA2 - 'COME TOGETHER' PROJECT

Twenty students from the first-year Spanish Baccalaureate will carry out a European project with the Fritz-Winger-Gesamtschule German college in Ahlen. They will be working on the importance of Europe, democratic values and the building of a common project through workshops, conferences and talks in this German city. It is a K2 project of the Erasmus programme and is funded by the European Union Erasmus+...

PENNY PRESS MACHINE

This year, students from the Middle-Level VET in Mechanisation and teachers from the Mechanics and Automotive Department are participating in the ERASMUS+ Penny Press Machine European project which is intended to design and build a machine to press cents and will be implemented with the collaboration of five European colleges. The project will be carried out in the different cycles of the module and will run for two years. A total of 5 meetings are scheduled to be held in the course, the first of which was held in Luxembourg in November 2019.

The second-year students of the Middle-Level Business Management and Higher-Level Business and Finances VETs attended the Luxembourg Practice Enterprises Tradeshow to implement the make-believe **companies** methodology and to make contact with other colleges and companies. The meeting also served to practice English, which is indispensable in training and in business in Europe.











EDUCATIONAL OFFERING

Innovation and entrepreneurship are the two cornerstones of our training offer. Salesians Sarrià offers Middle- and Higherlevel VET, the Spanish Baccalaureate and the International Baccalaureate.

More than 90% of the training cycles imparted at the college have been adapted to Dual VET, a methodology that facilitates access to the job world before the students actually complete their education. Cooperative learning, employed to encourage students to work together and in coordination, will provide Baccalaureate students with the training they need to be successful in companies in the future.

EDUCATIONAL OFFERING

Spanish Baccalaureate

The purpose of Baccalaureate studies is to provide students with integrated and multi-faceted training so that they can go into higher University education with the necessary guarantees and knowledge.

When they finish compulsory secondary education, students need to choose their future path and postcompulsory education courses: **Baccalaureate or Vocational Education and Training**. One of the options afforded to young people is Baccalaureate studies.

Salesians Sarrià offers **six Baccalaureate itineraries: technology, science, health sciences, social sciences, humanities and the arts**. These studies have a duration of two academic years and are divided into two different areas: one containing subjects that are common to all the courses and another specialising in the subjects more related to each area.

Baccalaureate classes seek to motivate students and are also designed to engage the students and all the class in order to facilitate learning of the different subjects. Thus, besides learning how to work as a team, they become independent students. Language-learning is one of the college keys to learning. English is an indispensable language in academia and in employment. This is why we promote language-learning in the classes. The college's work in this area has led it to be certified as a **Multilingual College** by virtue of the effort made in international projects and in the promotion of foreign languages.

Salesians Sarrià teaches the Spanish Baccalaureate in the mornings from Monday to Friday, from 8.00 am to 2.30 pm, whereas some afternoons are used for the Research assignment.

Students that wish to do this course must hold the (Spanish) Compulsory Secondary Education (ESO) certificate or have completed a Middle-Level VET course.

COOPERATIVE LEARNING

This methodology promotes both pupil independence and teamwork. The classes are intended to motivate students to nurture their own and their classmates' potential.



International Baccalaureate

The International Baccalaureate prepares students to further develop their intellectual, personal, emotional and social skills in a global setting.

CAUR DOA

Salesians Sarrià is an authorised Centre for teaching the **International Baccalaureate®** (IB) **Diploma Programme**. These courses are designed to promote independent and international personality in a cooperative setting.

The Diploma Programme targets young people aged between 16 and 19 years who wish to train in an **environment that furthers their international vocation and also achieve** a high degree of personal and social responsibility. The objective of these courses is to develop their depth of thought and to build a solid base for their growth.

The **International Baccalaureate** is a two-year course recognised for the Spanish Baccalaureate (LOMCE) + the general phase of the PAU (University Entrance Examination). The following requirements are needed to be eligible for these courses:

- Hold the title of Compulsory Secondary Education (CSE) or equivalent or have studied in foreign educational systems.
- Pass an initial interview.
- Have a suitable CSE record.

The IB qualification will enable students to enter national and international universities.

SUPPORTIVE STUDENTS:

The IB helps to form reflexive, open-minded and supportive students who can contribute to a better and more peaceful world.

The IB promotes and develops an international mentality. It promotes exchanges with other colleges and language-learning.

VET courses

Vocational and Educational Training (VET) is intended to help students to train for a profession in a practical and motivational setting. Salesians Sarrià has a broad range of VET courses, 90% of which are imparted in the dual modality.

DUAL MIDDLE-LEVEL VET

The objective is for students to acquire the knowledge they need **to find a job**.

Access to these courses is through the Compulsory Secondary Education Certificate (CSE) or its equivalent. Students may also be eligible for Middle-Level VET if they pass an entrance examination.

Passing the training programme qualifies them as **technicians**.

Salesians Sarrià offers these courses from Monday to Friday, from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm.

Academic opportunities:

- **1.** A Higher degree through direct access or through an entrance examination.
- 2. Any other Middle-Level VET or Baccalaureate.

DUAL HIGHER-LEVEL VET

These courses are intended for students who seek a **practical higher education** that will enable them to make their way in the job world. The students are awarded a middle-management certification.

Access to these courses is with the **Baccalaureate qualification**, a **Middle-Level VET** or by entrance examination.

After passing the Higher-Level VET students receive the qualification of **higher technician..**

Salesians Sarrià offers this education in the afternoons, from Monday to Friday, **from 3:30 pm to 9 pm.**

Academic opportunities:

- Direct access to university education with official recognition of credits depending on the source education.
- 4. To any other Higher-Level VET



NEW HIGHER-LEVEL AUTOMOTIVE VET

Beginning in the academic year 2020-2021, we will be teaching the New Higher-Level Automotive VET course. This new cycle is structured to ensure that the students acquire the knowledge they need to work in the sustainable automotive industry. To this end, the new VET will place emphasis on the new non-pollutant mobility possibilities.

EDUCATIONAL OFFERING

Educational **Innovation**

Salesians Sarrià's training offer is based on innovation. Our challenge is to train young people who will be in a position to provide solutions to companies and to society.

Our constant work and the consolidation of innovation-based studies have been acknowledged by the Department of Education of the Government of Catalonia in the form of the **Certificate of Pedagogical Innovation**, awarded to the college by dint of its projects and methodologies applied to Vocational Education and Training.

Salesians Sarrià has been working for seven years now with **Project-based Learning (PBL)** applied to the VET courses. This methodology is based on learning by competencies and is implemented according to current entrepreneurial needs. The objective is to train young people who will manage their own learning and will be capable of dealing with any problems they encounter. .

90% of our Vocational Education and Training is given in the Dual modality. The purpose of this format is to improve students competencies and how they interact with companies. Students who work in Dual VET alternate between in-class and in-company training. This affords them an added value in their professional future, while also catering to the needs of the collaborating companies.



MetròpolisFPLab

Raúl Adame and **Àlex Puertas**, students from Middle-Level VET in Digital Pre-Press, won the design of the **logotype of MetròpolisFPLab**. Both students were selected to represent the image of the project organised by the Fundación BCN Formació Professional and with the support of Innobaix, the Port of Barcelona and the Circuito de Barcelona-Catalunya.

An App for a robotic arm

The students from the Higher-Level VET in Automation and Industrial Robotics have created a robot that interacts and plays with the user. It is an **App for a robotic arm which dispenses chocolate** to clients and is intended to bring robotics closer to young children. It also has a Bluetooth system that allows the robot to be controlled from a tablet.

EDUCATIONAL OFFERING

Dual **VET**

More than 90% of our Middle-Level and Higher-Level VET courses are taught in the dual modality. These courses combine in-college and in-company training and facilitate access by young people to the job world.

Dual training is an opportunity to **improve our students' competencies** as well as their relationship with the company, affording them access to companies from the very beginning of post-compulsory education.

The Dual modality enables students to **alternate between training in the college** and more theoretical classes and more production-related training and activities in the company.

Salesians Sarrià has a **Dual VET coordinator** tasked

with managing the courses, reaching agreements with companies and institutions, and also with training the company tutors. This figure is essential in providing support to everyone involved in these courses..

They are part of the **Dual VET Alliance** in order to improve young people's employability. It is an integrated organisation for companies, institutions and educational centres that seeks to improve young people's employability through a quality education.

College - company Department

Job placement is one of young peoples' major concerns when they complete their education. Salesians Sarrià is working to make access to the job world more straightforward and without involving a major upheaval for young people. In order to accomplish this, we work with companies and institutions in order for them to help students.

Our **College-Company department** has been conceived to foster awareness of job world requirements, the most necessary and sought-after profiles, as well as the skills that candidates should have. This knowledge is used to promote student job placement and to offer them their first paid employment.

In most cases, the **FCT** or **Dual VET** are students' first-ever contact with the job world. Through these programmes, which provide Middle-Level and Higher-Level VET students with work experience, the companies

that work with the college can source talent that they can use and we help them to find the profile they are looking for.

The service offered by the College-Company Department engages exclusively in **establishing and maintaining the link between students and companies.** In this way, we get organisations and institutions to collaborate in the learning process, and they also provide young people with guidance, assisting them throughout their stay with the company.



RELATIONSHIP WITH BUSINESS

Employment Exchange

The relationship with companies is fundamental in **achieving quality employment** for young people. One of the objectives of Salesians Sarrià is for students, once they have completed their education, to find a job suited to their training, skills and professional career.

All the students and former alumni of Salesians Sarrià have an **online platform that enables them to contact different companies**. Here, they can register as job-seekers, include their résumé, list their skills and capacities and also specify what type of job they are looking for.

This space is also useful for companies, since they can send our **College-Company Department** their job vacancies, specifying the profile they seek. The college personnel take care of drawing up a shortlist for the profile being sought from among the candidates, and ultimately identify the student that is best suited to the vacancy.

Collaborating companies can access this service. Their involvement in the **employment exchange** allows them to source with highly-qualified professionals who are endorsed by the college.

As far as the students are concerned, the employment exchange has a set of **advantages that guarantees them contact with the job world** before they complete their education. They are informed of vacancies related to their speciality and are also provided with the support and the guidance they need when looking for a job..

THEBLUEDOTS

The first project developed in the co-working space is now a reality. The coworkers **Adrián Gastón** and **Roger Moreta**, after a year and a half as users of the service, successfully completed their spell in the co-working space following the conclusion of the development phase of their artificial intelligence project. **TheBlueDots** is a data monitoring and processing project for agriculture based on smart devices. We are truly proud to have hosted the **TheBlueDots** team in our Co-working space and their entrepreneurial artificial intelligence project applied to agriculture designed to optimise resources. We are convinced that it will be a resounding success and will respect the sustainability of fields of crops.

E-TUPPER PROJECT

One of the projects currently ongoing at the co-working space is E-Tupper, which heats food with no need for any other device, such as microwave. **David del Campo**, former pupil of the **Automation and Industrial Robotics Higher-Level VET**, and his collaborator **David Prados**, are working on this idea, which is intended to help people who cannot eat at home to prepare their meals either at work or at college.

"Train for your own safety" workshop

Baccalaureate and VET students took part in the "Train for your own safety" workshop about safe motorbike riding organised by the **Servei Català de Trànsit**. The workshop combined theory and practice to learn about and practice the techniques needed to control and master these vehicles.





Training talks for parents

Once again this year, different training **talks were organised about adolescence** for the parents of the college's students. Different presentations were given, dealing with young people's training needs, concerns and how families can cooperate and help them.

4th edition of Salesians Sarrià x Enterprise

The college held the fourth edition of the Salesians Sarrià x Enterprise, which is intended to disseminate good practices in VET. This year's edition was attended by more than 80 companies, with the focus on **CT Ingenieros** on account of its involvement in student training and in-company work experience.





The best entrepreneurs in Europe

The four former students of Baccalaureate who created "**Take this Way**" received their recognition as the best entrepreneurs in Europe at the **Youth Start European Entrepreneurship Award 2018**. Their project is an app whose purpose is to facilitate the payment of public transport in Barcelona.

We open the first green roof

On November 26, we opened the first Green Roof in the "**Green Roofs**" competition organised by the City Council of Barcelona. This space occupies a surface area of 191 m2 and there are two wind turbines, a drip irrigation system, an insect hotel plus an aromatic plants area and a vertical wall.





Visit by Sanmenxia College

The college director, **José Abascal**, and the head of International Relations, **Laura Ramírez**, met a delegation from the **Sanmenxia Plytechnic College** in China. The purpose of the meeting was to explain our educational system and the Salesians Sarrià pedagogical innovation model.

Press review
