As the managers of a Salesian college with a very unique identity, how would you describe the essence of this personality in the day-to-day running of the college, and how does it specifically translate into the all-round training (academic, personal and values) of the young people who pass through your classrooms?

First and foremost, our college is one that welcomes each young person just the way they are, providing them with a space for healthy socialisation. We set them on the right path in life, endowing them with a well-rounded and complete vision that combines an excellent education and the model of the person of Christ. Our educational model – the Preventive System – is based on critical thought and dialogue with young people; on the offer of a model for the individual and Christian values, and on the immediate, kind and constant presence of our educators. Personal mentoring, catering to diversity and promoting a family atmosphere and trust are core elements of our college.

In your opinion, what are this college's cornerstones in post-compulsory education and how do you work to continue to hold this position, given that you are a benchmark for other colleges?

Our leadership in post-compulsory teaching, particularly in Vocational Education and Training, is built upon several cornerstones. First of all, tradition and adaptation: we have a great deal of experience in VET and are attuned to the job market and technological progress. A second cornerstone is quality and academic rigour, since we have an expert faculty

and well-equipped facilities that can simulate real-life work settings. A third aspect is our close relationship with the business world: we collaborate with more than 800 companies, enabling us to adapt our syllabi to real needs and guarantee quality work experience (Dual VET). Finally, I would underscore the educational mentoring of each and every student.

The quality of your syllabi is one of your strong points. Would you like to share a methodology, innovative project or specific pedagogical approach you are currently implementing that you regard as key to your students' academic success and motivation?

Curricular quality is definitely one of our priorities. One clear example of our innovative approach is Project-Based Learning (PBL), which we apply particularly to VET. To complement the master classes, we also provide spaces where pupils work as teams to deal with real-life problems or develop complex projects by simulating professional environments. Moreover, we continue to promote Dual VET, where learning pivots between the college and the company, thereby providing real-life and highly-motivating work experience. In this regard, we also encourage our students to participate in contests and competitions.

Your international vocation is an added value. Would you care to elaborate upon how this vocation is embodied in the different educational levels and what specific benefits (exchanges, projects, language skills, global approach) this provides to VET or Baccalaureate students?

Our international vocation is a keystone and takes the form of several initiatives. On the one hand, we have the Erasmus+ programmes, which facilitate student mobility, enabling them to glean work experience in European companies or study at other colleges. We also host students and faculty from other countries, which further enhances our multicultural atmosphere. Moreover, we take part in European projects, collaborating with colleges and organisations from other countries, which allows our students to work on international teams and tackle global topics or issues. Finally, we encourage language-learning: English, as an academic and professional language, is now the norm in our college, meaning that our VET and Baccalaureate students use it as just another tool that contributes to their personal and professional training and qualifications. Around 50% of our faculty hold language qualifications.

Collaboration with companies is of the essence, particularly in VET. Could you give some examples of strategic collaborations that have worked particularly well, and explain how such alliances have a direct impact on the employability and the suitability of the education provided to the students to cover job market demands?

We have a network of more than 800 collaborating companies. There are numerous and different examples of successful collaboration. On the one hand, we develop Dual VET programmes with ground-breaking companies from the sectors linked to the professional categories that we teach. We also invite professionals from the business world to give talks and workshops to provide an updated overview of the sector. These companies also lend us equipment or software, so our workshops are equipped with cutting-edge technology. Last but not least, we implement joint innovation projects to cater to technological or production requirements with the active involvement of our students.

Non-academic activities, those that reach beyond the classroom, usually play an important role in Salesian teaching. What kind of activities are prominent at your college and what role do they play in helping students to develop skills and talents and in fostering the family atmosphere and companionship so characteristic of Don Bosco?

The Salesian 'playground' continues to be a privileged educational space. Salesians Sarrià offers a broad range of activities to complement its academic training, which are essential to all-round development. The MJS (Salesians Youth Movement) youth centre is a free-time meeting point which stages sports activities and develops faith-building paths and social commitment opportunities to foster social awareness, not to mention cultural and artistic activities (drama group, guitar group, book club), all of which enables our young people to discover and hone their talents. We also organise togetherness activities and outings to strengthen the bond between schoolmates and educators outside the classroom, as well as the college's own special festivities, such as the Don Bosco or Maria Auxiliadora celebrations.

From the moment a pupil walks into the college until they complete their education, what type of mentoring and Salesian values do you seek to instil in them for their personal and professional development?

Mentoring is the backbone of our teaching method. From the very first day, each

and every pupil has a tutor who is their point of reference: someone who will listen to, guide and help them to overcome difficulties. This mentoring extends to the personal, academic and vocational domains. The values that we seek to convey are honesty viewed as integrity; responsibility at work and civic-mindedness; happiness and optimism, creating a positive atmosphere in which young people feel happy and motivated to learn and grow; effort and the pursuit of excellence, encouraging them to do their best at all times and to persevere in the face of difficulty or hardship; solidarity, promoting involvement in and a commitment to building a fairer world; and faith and transcendence, offering the possibility to discover and nurture their spiritual dimension with Gospel-based values as a guiding light in their life.

The educational and job world are evolving all the time. How does the college prepare to rise to the challenges the future will bring?

Our strategy is based on several axes. Firstly, we are always on the look-out for new professions: we strive to stay abreast of job market trends to adapt our training offer: one example is the new Electromechanical Maintenance course we started this year. Sustainability also lies at the heart of everything we do, whether in projects or college management, and we also promote environmental awareness among our students. We are committed to the development of soft skills such as critical thought, creativity, communication or adaptability, using an assessment system to track these skills. We foster entrepreneurship by encouraging and supporting our students' initiatives and providing them with tools such as co-working spaces. Finally, we bolster our networks and alliances with other educational institutions, companies and organisations to share knowledge and develop innovative projects.

The teaching and non-teaching team is the driving force of any educational project. How does your college promote commitment, lifelong learning and a family spirit amongst the educators in order to bring this Salesian proposal to fruition?

We would be unable to fulfil this mission without the commitment and the professionalism of all our personnel, both teaching and non-teaching. We encourage their involvement through specific training on our educational style and our identity, as well as ongoing training in different areas to ensure that they are up to date and ready to tackle the emerging challenges. We promote teamwork and collaboration between departments and stages, sharing good practices and supporting each other. We strive to guarantee a positive working environment based on trust and respect, one in which everyone feels appreciated and listened to.

What message would you like to convey to your current students, their families, future students and the educational community as a whole as to what being part of this big Salesian family means, as well as the opportunities the college can offer them?

We would tell our current students to keep making the most of all the opportunities offered to them by Salesians Sarrià. They are the beating heart of our 'home': their happiness, effort and dreams drive us on every day. We would tell the families: thank you for trusting us. Your collaboration is essential to the training process and together we make a great team. Our message to future students and families would be: the doors of Salesians Sarrià are open to you. You will find a homely environment, committed professionals and a broad range of opportunities to grow and to prepare you for life. Being a part of the Salesians Sarrià family is not just about studying or working at a college: it is about being the "main character" in your own story. It is about sharing a mission, a style and a hope. It is about believing in young people and helping them to realise all their potential. And together we shall continue to build this passionate project that was started by Don Bosco. ■

In parallel, we work with the Fundació Magone, an organisation sponsored by the Salesians of the Maria Auxiliadora Inspectorate, which operates throughout Catalonia and implements initiatives targeting the most vulnerable people in our setting.



The Bosco Run

On 26 January, we held the ninth edition of The Bosco Run, in the course of which 300-plus runners completed a 5-km run on the streets of the neighbourhood of Sarrià-Sant Gervasi. Once again, this event would not have been possible without the solidarity of the runners and the commitment of 150 volunteers. A genuine show of community spirit!



'SHARE' INTERNATIONAL VOLUNTEER PROJECT

In collaboration with the English Farnborough Salesian college and the Salesian Sisters of the City of Joy Home, every summer we send students and teachers from the college to a town in the south of Zambia to participate in different aid initiatives for young Zambians. This is a personal growth experience through which we seek to promote social awareness and the supportive commitment of our educational community.

This year, this charity project celebrated its 10th anniversary, which is why we organised a commemorative exhibition in our college. Every photograph could tell the story of unique experiences that will be forever imprinted on the participants' minds.

SUSTAINABLE SCHOOL FOR A MORE RESPONSIBLE FUTURE



Salesians Sarrià nurtures students' commitment to sustainability, cultivating values to build a greener and more responsible future. And to prove that we practice what we preach, here are some of our most outstanding ecological projects!

Don Bosco Green Alliance

Salesians Sarrià is part of the 'Don Bosco Green Alliance' international initiative, a project that gets our students involved in environmental protection to train a new generation of citizens committed to sustainability.

A 'green lung' in the college

Six years ago, we started our 'green roof' as part of the Barcelona City Council's Green Roofs project. This infrastructure is now a learning tool for the Higher VET students in Renewable Energies, since it is equipped with devices such as photovoltaic solar panels, two wind turbines and a weather station.

ICTA Agreement

Salesians Sarrià has a collaboration agreement with the Institute of Environmental Science and Technology (ICTA) to transfer knowledge and to implement joint actions.



Sustainable waste management

We work actively to implement a circular economy that minimises and improves waste management. One clear example of this is the use of new drinking water fountains to reduce the use of disposable containers.



We are a UNESCO School

Salesians Sarrià enjoys the UNESCO's recognition as part of its Associated Schools Network. This worldwide network is comprised of more than 10,000 schools and brings together more than 180 countries to share values such as sustainability, peace, internationalisation and solidarity.



Sustainable mobility

The environmental challenges of the 21st century call for sustainable mobility. For this reason, we have adapted our installations to promote the use of public transport and other means such as bicycles or electric vehicles with a view to reducing environmental impact.



For a city with more trees

Salesians Sarrià has planted trees in the school yard over the last few years, improving air quality in Barcelona and creating a more welcoming space for the community. This initiative is part of the school's commitment to sustainability and environmental education.



Renewable energy through plant photosynthesis

The CyberGreen Lab project, carried out by VET students from our college, together with Salesianos Palma del Río and the NechiGroup and Amaysys Technologies companies, generates renewable energy by leveraging a photosynthesis process of plants installed on a green wall. This initiative comprises different Industry 4.0-specific technologies, such as artificial intelligence, 3D printing and cybersecurity, and is also aligned with the UN Sustainable Development Goals.



INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

We are part of the European Community and we participate in a globalised economy. To this end, we promote the internationalisation of our educational community (students and faculty) through language-learning, stays abroad, cultural exchanges and collaborations with schools from other countries.



Small conversation groups

To encourage the hands-on learning of English, French and German, we organise small conversation groups at midday with our teachers, most of whom are native speakers. We also provide our teachers with language-training. Languages need to be spoken!



Official Cambridge examinations

We are an authorised preparatory centre for the official Cambridge exams, a training endorsement for students' academic and employment future. Students can prepare for the First Certificate (B2) and Advanced (C1) exams with us!



Certified as a multi-language college

Our vocation to internationalise our educational community has merited recognition from the Christian School Foundation of Catalonia, which is comprised of some 400 schools, which awarded us its multilingual college certificate.



Language assistants

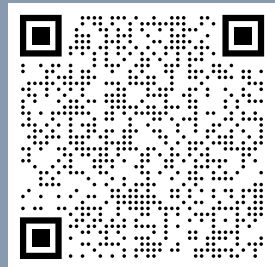
Erasmus+

EXCHANGE BETWEEN CHILE AND BARCELONA

Students and teachers from the Col·legi Tècnic Industrial Don Bosco Antofagasta and Don Bosco Calama schools, together with representatives of the Associació d'Industrials d'Antofagasta (AIA), spent a week in Barcelona on an educational, cultural and business exchange as part of the collaboration agreement that both schools signed with Salesians Sarrià last year.

The Chilean students participated actively in different workshops at which they had access to technologies such as 3D printers or articulated robots. The Chilean teachers held meetings with our own team in order to share methodologies, educational practices and own experiences. Beyond the academic

aspect, the delegation also visited prominent companies from our industrial sector, other Salesian network institutions such as the EUSS or Salesianes Santa Dorotea, and iconic sites in the city, such as the Hospital of Sant Pau or Tibidabo Temple.

The head teacher of Salesians Sarrià, Xavier Brines, rated the visit very positively, highlighting the fact that "it was an excellent opportunity to exchange knowledge and experiences with other Salesian schools from outside Europe". Don Bosco Antofagasta and Don Bosco Calama are part of the Fundació Educacional Regió de la Minería, comprised of the Archbishopric of Antofagasta and the Associació d'Industrials d'Antofagasta.

Almost 400 students have done these courses with us since 2016, obtaining outstanding results: in the 2023-2024 academic year, 97.2% of the students passed with a higher average grade than the schools all over the world that teach this programme (31.6 for the Salesians versus 30.3 overall).

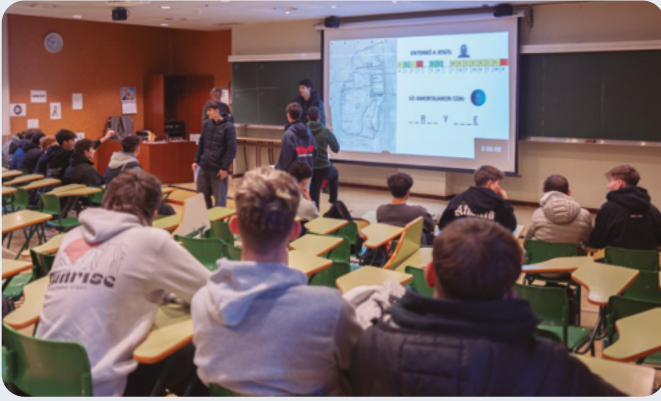
CATHOLIC SCHOOLS CONGRESS

JANUARY | 2025



REFLECTION ON USING OUR MOBILES

Under the title 'Free us from the mobile: from total distraction to the possibility of resonance], we staged a joint thought-provoking lecture involving personnel from the Santa Dorotea college and the Escola Universitària Salesiana de Sarrià (EUSS), given by Xavier Casanovas, a member of the Department of Ethics and Christian Thought of the IQS. NEW ALLIANCE WITH HEXAGON

This environment will enable our Electricity, Electronics and Mechanics students to access cutting-edge technology and put the learnings acquired in the classroom into practice much more efficiently.

This year's Bosco Run for charity, held jointly with the Salesianes Santa Dorotea, brought together more than 300 runners, grouped by age, who took to the streets of the Sarrià-Sant Gervasi neighbourhood. It was the ninth edition of a charity event which this year once again featured the collaboration of 150 volunteers. The proceeds from the race will be donated to the 'Repassem Junts' (Let's Revise Together) project.

VISIT BY THE COVEY COMPANY

COVEY, a van rental company, paid our Motor Vehicle Department a visit to present their new philosophy and how they work, as well as to give us an updated overview of the automotive sector and the career plan they offer to students who do their work experience with them if they are eventually hired.



PREP4PRO EUROPEAN PROJECT

Our college auditorium was the scenario chosen to present the results of the Erasmus+ KA220 project that promotes the Prep4Pro European initiative that seeks to bolster the long-term international mobility of VET students. We hosted the internationalisation coordinators and VET directors, as well as the students doing this course.

CITIZEN COUNCIL FOR SUSTAINABILITY

We took part in the Plenary Session of the Citizen Council for Sustainability, chaired by Laia Bonet, Deputy Mayor of the Barcelona City Council. MARCH | 2025



DON BOSCO AWARD

There were a great many international exchanges in our Baccalaureates in March! One group of students headed for the Salesian college Don Bosco Sint-Pieters in Ghent (Belgium), while another group travelled to the Czech college Dvořákovo gymnázium Kralupy nad Vltavou. In parallel, our college hosted a group of students from the Fritz-Winter-Gesamtschule college in Ahlen (Germany).



TRADE FAIR IN PRAGUE

The second-year students of the VET Courses in Administrative Management, and Administration and Finance took part in the International Practice Enterprise Trade Fair 2025, held in Prague (Czech Republic). At the Fair, they got to engage in buying and selling and negotiation activities with the two practice companies from the Administration Department: Llibres i Revistes EDB (Intermediate VET) and Hotel Bosco Barcelona (Higher VET).



EDUCATION FAIR

Once again this year, we participated in the Education Fair, one of the must-attend events of the education sector in Catalonia, held in the Montjuïc trade fair venue. We were very satisfied with the large number of visitors to our stand, who were very interested in what makes the Salesians colleges so unique, as well as in our post-compulsory education offer. UNESMUN 2025

Some of our first-year International Baccalaureate students took part in the ninth edition of UNESMUN in Madrid, featuring the participation of more than 200 students from Spain and Mexico. UNESMUN is an educational and cultural activity that simulates real-life negotiations between countries within the United Nations framework. Our students had to represent South Africa, and they did a great job!

BLOOD DONATION

This year we organised two blood-donation campaigns during the year! The first one was in November, with a turnout of 64 people, and the second was held in April, in the course of which 94 members of our community stepped up to give blood. We are a health-minded college that promotes these habits among our young people to improve their well-being.

WHEN REALITY HELPS YOU TO UNDERSTAND FICTION

We were visited by Carolyn Daher, a public health researcher and international development worker, who came to provide food for thought about politics, religion and human rights. She also talked about what it was like to live in Afghanistan in 2001, with insights that helped our students to fully understand the novel by Afghan writer Khaled Hosseini, *The Kite Runner*, which they are currently reading.





ST GEORGE'S DAY

We celebrated St George's Day (Sant Jordi) with different cultural and literary activities in the school yard, such as the traditional sale of roses and books for charity, live music shows, or the St George's Day competition award ceremony. This year, the Art Baccalearate students also prepared two workshops: one for the screen printing of tote bags and t-shirts and another one for origami with roses.

INDUSTRIAL ELECTRIC VEHICLE DAY

We organised an industrial electric vehicle day featuring the attendance of two companies: JAC Motors, which specialises in the manufacture of light commercial vehicles, and Circontrol, a specialist in solutions for more efficient mobility and electric vehicle charging. The students were treated to talks by experts and hands-on workshops!



ETHICAL HACKING COURSE

What techniques do hackers use? How can we defend ourselves from cyber attacks? We realise that cybersecurity has great potential now and even more in the future, so we set up an online course for students to learn the basics of ethical hacking. The proceeds from the course went to the Share volunteer project.



VISIT TO WALLBOX

The Technology Baccalaureate students visited the headquarters of Wallbox Chargers, an enterprise that specialises in the manufacture of smart charging systems that manage communication between vehicle, grid, building and charger. They operate in over 98 countries and have more than 900 employees in their offices in Europe, Asia and the Americas.

WORKSHOPS ON HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS

Our college's Educational Psychology Service prepared a series of workshops on healthy couple relationships, during which the concept of healthy emotional bonds was explained to them, as well as how to identify a toxic relationship or specific unhealthy behaviours. This initiative is intended to help them to learn the limits of respect and the importance of self-esteem.



FAMILY TALKS

As occurs every academic year, students' mothers and fathers got the chance to attend different training talks by renowned experts about topics or issues that are fundamental in adolescence, such as mental health, emotion management, family values or professional future. 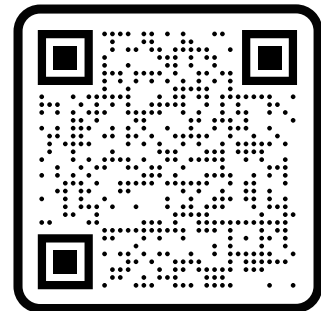

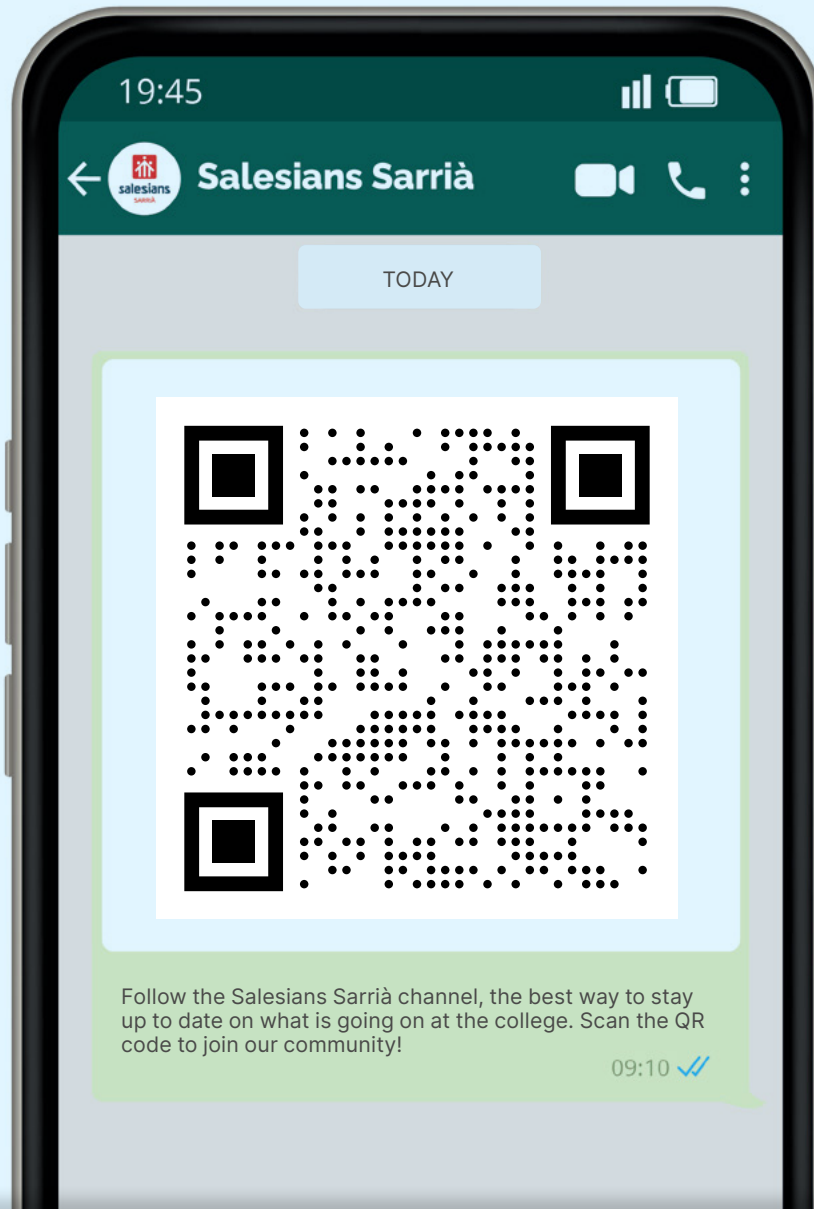
